### **Energia Cura NBOS Standards of Conduct**

Energia Cura (EC) on behalf of Fairbanks Pipeline Company (FPC) is conducting a non-binding open season for its Interior Alaska natural gas-line project. EC will administer this non-binding open season under rules of conduct set forth within FERC, AGA, ERGEG, and CEER guidelines. In doing so, EC strives to ensure open, non-discriminatory, and transparent access for Alaskan consumers by following the summation of said standards shown below:

#### **The administration of open seasons will be conducted on a non-discriminatory basis**

Energia Cura will provide equal access to non-binding open season information to all Interested Parties. No Interested Party will be given an unfair advantage in the non-binding open season process.

#### **Energia Cura will not employ any person or entity as a conduit to disclose non-public information**

Energia Cura will keep confidential and prohibit unauthorized access to all non-public information (records) including information provided by and about Interested Parties. Energia Cura will not disclose or use any conduit to disclose information submitted and marked under confidentiality or as further prescribed within bound Confidentiality Agreements.

#### **Energia Cura will conduct its non-binding open season on a “Transparent” basis**

Energia Cura will provide equal access to all non-public open season information, not excluded by its bound confidentially agreements, to all Interested Parties. Energia Cura may discuss a specific request for information without disclosing the information to other Interested Parties.

#### **Implementation**

All Energia Cura employees assigned to the administration of FPC’s open seasons have reviewed these applicable rules of conduct and Energia Cura’s management directive requiring full compliance with these standards.
